In terms of personal application for us, we are kind and forgiving to those who love us and to those who hate us. We all have real or imagined enemies.			
Saving Grace Ephesians 2:8-9			
Saving Grace is the grace applied to the unbeliever who makes the decision to believe on and accept as their savior, Jesus Christ. Once this takes place, we receive a great number of blessings that are permanent and irreversible. All of these are points that show salvation is eternal, not temporal.

For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.'

Living Grace is all that God provides for the Believer once they become saved. It is also called the *Much More of God!*

Think of it --- when we were in our grime --- when we had no knowledge --- or just didn't care about God, He sent His son to die for each of us personally. If this is the case, now that you have become His child, how *much more* will He do for you?

Think of your child --- if you have any --- if they are in your living room with other children and you have the opportunity to gift them with four years of college tuition --- will you give it to a neighbor's child or your own?
