Remember, we have three types of sin we discussed and three ways to sin.

- A. Imputed--- Inherited --- Personal sin
- B. Mental --- Tongue --- Overt

Solutions to the Problem of the Sin Nature

God has arranged to provide all that is needed to deal with the problems caused by the Sin Nature in a believer's life. The personal sins of the individual were borne by Jesus Christ on the Cross. 1 Pet. 2:24. These sins will never be mentioned again because they have already been judged in Christ. Rev. 20:12.

.....

Romans 11:6 'And if by grace, then it is no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.'

2) How do you know the difference between good works and works of the flesh?

I think often we can confuse, trick ourselves, or just completely miss when we do works that are "wood, hay and stubble".

I Corinthians 3:10-15 'According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.'

Even the best of us want what we want, so we put our best foot forward, we manipulate, or people-please, to get an intended result.

The Hazards of Negative Volition

The Apostle Paul issued a stern warning to mature Christian believers living at Ephesus when he told them to beware of falling into a state of indifference to, or antagonism to, the Word of God. He stated that if they were to become negative to the Lord's

teachings, their lives would very quickly become indistinguishable from those of unbelievers in terms of fruitfulness and Christian character.

.....

Ephesians 4:17-19 'This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.'

It is obvious Paul is saying many will backslide! This is scary stuff.

3) Name ways you have had negative volition as a Christian:

You may not want to answer that, but I promise you God already knows.

As a result, this whole search for happiness outside of God's Plan can NEVER bring you peace.
