Another thing is noteworthy here. Naaman is converted, and I'm sure he experienced a lot of ramifications from others. He swears allegiance to God but asks permission to keep up a front of allegiance to his nation's gods. (*Verses 17-19*)

The point here is, we bring God to ungodly people. We worship, and are believers, yet sometimes we are in uncomfortable environments. Sometimes a Christian at a grocery store may have to sell cigarettes and liquor. This can be spiritually uncomfortable.
