John 14:15-18 '"If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.'

Hebrews 13:5-6 'Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

I want to reassure you today that God loves you. He knows what is troubling you.

John 14:25-27 "These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.'

Jesus promised to give us peace... not as the world gives. How can you personally find that today..... that *Philippians 4:6-7* peace?

Think on what is troubling you. How does God see this issue? Is He worried at all? Why not? You see, that is your peace because you share in Jesus' destiny. You are going to the same place. He has promised you.

How can you find peace... that peace that always seems to elude you? By having confidence in the outcome and by claiming the promises.
