

Luke Chapter 8:19-40

A Sower Went Out to Sow - Part 2

Luke 6 --- we talked about love, forgiveness --- i.e., not judging, and then our foundation built on these things!!

Luke 7 --- faith --- all kinds of faith.

Luke 8 --- we moved into application of these truths.

Sowing with love --- non judgmental --- our light is for everyone --- forgiveness and faith.

Now it seems like we made a perfect circle from the condition of our heart --- to true service --- serving all.

HA --- is the learning ever done?

One of the things I always say is that EVERY scripture has three interpretations.

1. Literal
2. Figurative
3. Spiritual

The literal usually comes first. Figurative comes with learning. Spiritual understanding only comes through the teaching ministry of the Holy Spirit.

We have been exploring the spiritual --- which means we are looking from an angle that many times you have not.

Last week we began to understand that the parable of the sower is just that --- about the sower.

So where does Luke go next --- application.

Luke 8:19-40

1. What is the spiritual understanding of *Luke 8:19-21*?

Jesus is obviously pointing back to the parable He just taught. A light that has been lit is now a part of His body. Corporately, we are all one sower.....

Luke 8:22-25

In chapter 7, we just talked about faith.

2. What is the spiritual explanation of Luke 8:22-25?

Okay, so the stage is set.

Luke 8:26-40

Now let's do the lesson.

3. What is the spiritual understanding *Luke 8:26-40*?

Obviously, Jesus was there to sow a seed. This chapter speaks to Jesus as being God. He says He really has no earthly family. It's all a spiritual body and we are empowered by faith to do supernatural things.

Jesus had purpose and intent. He knew the end result.

Matthew 15:29-38

Decapolis --- Gerasenes --- same location --- different result.

4. What is the lesson here?

Let's pray that the one we put our light under the table for in the past, would fill us with excitement because of possibility.

1 Demoniac --- multitudes healed.
