Luke Chapter 9:1-6 & 10:1-12 A Tale of Two Field Trips

Okay --- are we ready for this? We have been studying like crazy and now we are doing something exciting. Aren't you excited every week because of the revelation of Jesus Christ through God the Holy Spirit to your soul? It's called edification, and you might find our studies hard to explain to other people. Today we will be talking about spiritual displacement and spiritual warfare and Holy Spirit Exercises.

II Peter 3:14-16

Let's pray for the Holy Spirit.

Today's first principle is this.

II Corinthians 10:3-7a

³ 'For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, ⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, ⁶ and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled. ⁷ Do you look at things according to the outward appearance?. '

The weapons of our warfare.

Luke 9:1-6 Matthew 10:1-20

1) What is your understanding of this principle and how does it apply to us?

We are about to learn the spiritual principle of spiritual displacement and we are going to expand on it. "if you say you are spiritual --- you believe....."

Jesus specifically gave the twelve authority for a specific time period.

Take nothing --- Faith in provision

Luke 10:1-14

2) What is different this time?

We learned about Holy Spirit exercises. If you want your quality of life (mental attitude) to increase --- make it a priority --- but like that exercise, this exercise will only work if done......

3) What is a Holy Spirit exercise?

Let's talk about the 70.

- a) Jesus sent them before Him.
- b) Where He Himself was about to go.

(We are intermediates) ... in the spiritual realm.

We invite Christ --- out loud ---.

We don't assume to know what God will do. We rest assured God will do something. Whatever it is, it is above our understanding.

c) Provisions --- our confidence is in His strength. We bring nothing to the battle but Christ.

II Corinthians 10:3-7

d) The rejection of these will result in their perishing.

You should not be upset, nor offended. You should mourn their death.

Luke 10:17-25

Jesus rejoices in the Spirit because you understand this lesson.

4) Explain Spiritual Displacement.

Let's do a Holy Spirit exercise.
