Romans 7:15-25 ¹⁵ For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. ¹⁶ If, then, I do what I will not to do, I agree with the law that it is good. ¹⁷ But now, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. ¹⁸ For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find. ¹⁹ For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice. ²⁰ Now if I do what I will not to do, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. ²¹ I find then a law, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good. ²² For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. ²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. ²⁴ O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ²⁵ I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin.

Maybe that is you --- struggling with sin. I know I do and most often, I don't understand why I can't just quit.

Deuteronomy 28:1-4, 15-17 "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. ² And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God: ³ "Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country. ⁴ "Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.

¹⁵ "But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you: ¹⁶ "Cursed shall you be in the city, and cursed shall you be in the country. ¹⁷ "Cursed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl.

- a) You will struggle with sin. Romans 7, Galatians 5
- b) God understands that and has made provision. John 14, Romans 7
- c) A Christian will never be at peace with sin. *Galatians 5*

SOLUTIONS:

- Psalm 119:11 knowing God's Word
 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.
- Psalm 101:3 Protecting my eye
 I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me.
- Proverbs 11:4 Get help
 Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, But righteousness delivers from death.
- I John 1:9 Confess and be healed.
 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

You must know the Spirit will NEVER be OK with sin. If you want peace, be obedient!
