Let's talk mental attitude.

1. How would you characterize your mental attitude?

Luke 17:1-4

We will not stay here today, but we will consider this again. Our role is forgiveness. What role does another's repentance play? Have you ever led someone into sin? Knowingly led someone? That's a whole other issue.

2. What if the person doesn't repent? After all, if someone doesn't repent with God, what happens?

3. Is forgiveness a duty?

Luke 17:5-10

What a wonderful picture of faith. Does everyone have faith? We have determined yes on several occasions, but faith in what? Could it be possible we have more faith in ourselves than in God?

4. Describe mustard seed faith.

In this same equation, the same scripture block, Jesus talks about works.

5. Do you rely on your works for forgiveness from God or to gain God's favor?
