

Pentecost and Year of Jubilee

Welcome back and here we go! This is truly a Spirit-inspired message today!

1) Sunday is _____ or the Feast of _____.

The Israelites call it the 50 Day Period of Anticipation, symbolic of the time from the departure from Egypt and entrance into Canaan, where they would enjoy the first fruits. Today it is symbolic for the giving of the first fruits of the Spirit of Pentecost.

Acts 2:1-21

This was a first fulfillment. Many prophecies have two or more fulfillments. The first is immediate to show that the one further out WILL come to pass.

Isaiah 7:10-17, 8:1-4

Signs of fulfillment of judgment.

Isaiah 9:6 – a sign of freedom!

I believe Pentecost was the first fulfillment. I believe this year is the second.

- We are in the Year of Jubilee
“canceled debts... liberation of slaves, and servants, land returned”
- This is Israel’s 77th anniversary.
- This Pentecost is widely considered to be a fulfillment and a year of spiritual enlightenment.
- This Year of Jubilee is widely considered to be a spiritual year of renewal and freedom.

2) We can find _____ from lifelong _____!

- We don’t have to be slaves to addictions, fear, lust, anger, hopelessness. We can find and receive healings and renewal. This year can be your year.

Romans 8:22-27 ²²*For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.* ²³*Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.* ²⁴*For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?* ²⁵*But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.*

²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. ²⁷ Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

3) The Apostles received the first _____.

If the Apostles were the first fruit, we are the harvest.

I don't have the time needed to go over prophecy being fulfilled today. But, I can tell you my experience. God has been using little miracles in your lives to build my confidence.

1 Corinthians 12:27-31 ²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. ²⁸ And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. ²⁹ Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? ³⁰ Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? ³¹ But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

4) Desire new _____!

I am always looking to grow in my gifts. I am always hoping for new healings. Why? So people are more confident in their God! These are always signs for your belief as a whole --- so share what is going on.

- What would freedom look like to you?

Freedom from fear, from loneliness, from ignorance, from powerlessness...

Are you ready for God to do something new in you? I think the pouring out has already begun. But I also think things will change fundamentally on Sunday. We are moving into the final days of this dispensation.
